

REGIONAL BALL DIAMOND USER BEHAVIOUR GUIDELINES

BANNERS, SIGNS & CLOTHING

- Signs, posters, clothing or messages with explicit language, profanity or derogatory characterization directed toward any person or groups are prohibited.
- Signs cannot be posted in or attached to the facility without prior approval.

CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES (ALCOHOL & CANNABIS)

- This facility adheres to Alberta's Gaming, Liquor and Cannabis Act and local bylaws regarding the use of controlled substances such as cannabis and alcoholic beverages in a public space.
- Alcohol is not permitted in the facility unless specifically approved in writing and subject to compliance with applicable regulations. This includes the ball diamonds, dugouts and spectators within the facility. Consumption of Alcohol in these facilities without written permission could result in personal fines.
- Tobacco products or consumption of cannabis is strictly prohibited in the facility, ball diamonds and dugouts.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

- Food is not permitted on any playing surface.
- Glass containers are discouraged. This will protect maintenance crews, and user groups, especially youth programs, from coming in contact with broken glass.
- All users must honour all food service contractual arrangements specific to the facility.

USER CONDUCT

- Profanity, aggressive and disrespectful behaviour between officials, facility staff, players, coaches, or spectators will not be tolerated.
- Spitting (including sunflower seeds) is discouraged and prohibited in some facilities, please help to keep the facility clean and sanitary for all user groups.
- Users must vacate dugouts in accordance with the facility's policy.
- Pets must be on a leash and are not permitted to be within 5 meters of the playing surface.
- Please refer to the provincial sport and recreation guidelines for more information.

The facility renter is responsible for the conduct of participants and spectators and for adhering to the facility booking process. The facility staff are responsible for the operation and general supervision of the facility and shall enforce these guidelines. Non-compliance of these guidelines may result in loss of booking privileges and/or removal from the facility. RCMP or Enforcement Services will be contacted if necessary. Additional fees may be levied if damages are incurred or if extra cleanup is required.
